 - Possible Physics Courses: Physics Waves and AP Physics
- Possible availability to Teach the Heart of Central curriculum

- Be professional and courteous in dealing with students, families, faculty and staff, and the general public.

Responsibilities

- Teach Applied Geometry, Algebra II, and Personal Finance curriculum
- Teach Heart of Central Curriculum and supervise class activities as needed.
- Communicate with students and parents about grades and assignments to help students be successful.
- Keep grades and class assignments up-to-date in FACTS Gradebook and Google Classroom.
- Create and lead an eight-day High School Mini-Term course.
- Complete written notes of appreciation of students to their families at least once a year.
- Monitor study hall as assigned or needed.
- School Committee participation as requested or assigned as needed.
- Attend chapel as a role model. Take attendance.
- Explore availability with stipend positions (ie. Science Olympiad, Student Council, etc..)
- Volunteer two times a year at school activities (athletic gate, ushering, etc.)
- Attend all CCS In-service meetings, all school meetings, and grade level meetings as scheduled
- Other duties as assigned or requested.
