- Teach Middle School Language Arts Curriculum
- Teach Middle School Exploratory Curriculum
- Teach Heart of Central Curriculum and supervise class activities as needed.
- Serve as a homeroom teacher and Heart of Central leader for one of the middle school grades
- Communicate with students and parents about grades and assignments to help students be successful.
- Keep grades and class assignments up-to-date in FACTS-RenWeb Gradebook and Google Classroom.
- Create and lead Middle School Mini-Term experiences.
- Supervise lunch and recess times – shared with colleagues
- Monitor study hall as assigned or needed.
- Complete written notes of appreciation of students to their families at least once a year
- Attend all CCS In-service meetings, all school meetings, and grade level meetings as scheduled
- Attend chapel as a role model. Take attendance.
- Attend Middle School concerts, dramas, and other planned activities as pertinent to the role and responsibilities of a CCS Middle School teacher.
- Volunteer two times a year for school activities (athletic gate, ushering, etc.)
- Coordinate Middle School Spelling Bee and Power of the Pen
- Other duties as assigned or requested
