Supervision

The High School Math Teacher reports to the Principal.

Responsibilities

- Teach assigned courses
- Teach Heart of Central Curriculum and supervise class activities as needed.
- Keep grades and class assignments up-to-date in FACTS-RenWeb Gradebook and Google Classroom, communicating with students and parents to help students be successful.
- Create and lead an eight-day High School Mini-Term course.
- Complete written notes of appreciation of students to their families at least once a year.
- Monitor study hall as assigned or needed.
- School Committee participation as requested or assigned as needed.
- Attend chapel as a role model. Take attendance.
- Other duties as assigned or requested.
