Scholarship Information

Legacy Music Scholarship is being offered to students who would like to begin or are currently taking private music lessons on any instrument or voice.



It covers half of the cost of private lessons for eligible Central Christian Students during the school year.

When a scholarship is awarded, payment will be made by the school directly to the instructor, and the family will be invoiced for the other 50% of the cost. Applicants who meet all criteria will be awarded scholarships on a first come, first served basis.



How to Apply

Eligibility Criteria:

- The student has a sincere desire to learn to play any instrument suitable for them or to develop their vocal abilities.
- The student receives free or reduced lunches OR is the second or third child in the family taking private lessons at CCS.
- The student will demonstrate sustained effort and progress in ability.
- Preference will be given to students NOT taking violin, viola, cello, or string bass, since the Anna Knutson Memorial String Scholarship was established to fund lessons for those specific instruments. Students who play guitar may apply for the Legacy Music Scholarship.
